- 1. This call for tenders follows the General Notice of Procurement published on the website www.gtai on March 8, 2018, on the DNCCP website on March 14, 2018, and in the national newspaper TOGO PRESSE on March 15, 2018.
- 2. This notice can be accessed on the website www.gtal starting from Friday, August 25, 2023, and will subsequently be available on the website dncmp-togo.com and in Togopresse starting from Monday, August 28, 2023.
- 3. The Government of the Togolese Republic has received a grant from the German Financial Cooperation through KfW for the financing of the Decentralization Support Program (PAD2) and intends to use a portion of this funding to make authorized payments for the execution of works contracts, the subject of this international call for tenders.
- 4. The Government, in agreement with KfW, has designated the Urban Works Execution Agency (AGETUR-TOGO) as the Delegated Client to manage, on its behalf and for its account, the PAD program. In this context, AGETUR-TOGO is requesting closed bids from eligible candidates meeting the required qualifications for the realization of commercial infrastructure works in the cities of Aného, Atakpamé, and Sotouboua, divided into three lots as follows:
  - Lot 1: Construction/rehabilitation of commercial infrastructure and sanitation of the Lagbonou market in Aného.
  - Lot 2: Construction/rehabilitation of commercial infrastructure and sanitation of the Agbonou small market in Atakpamé.
  - Lot 3: Construction/rehabilitation of commercial infrastructure and sanitation of the large market in Sotouboua.

A bidder can submit bids for all lots, but they can only be awarded one (1) lot.

Variants are not allowed.

The execution period is eighteen (18) months for each of the three lots

- 5. The procurement process will be conducted through an open international tender as defined in the applicable Public Procurement Code and its implementing regulations, in accordance with the new Procurement Guidelines, January 2021 version. These guidelines cover the Procurement of Consultancy Services, Civil Engineering Works, Installations, Supplies, and Various Services in Financial Cooperation with Partner Countries of KfW. ## Note:

Companies that have been awarded public contracts and have not achieved an execution rate of at least 70%, and are also behind schedule (meaning they have not completed the work within the specified time), are not eligible to participate in this current bidding process.

Newly established companies that are unable to provide financial statements for the years 2020, 2021, and 2022, as required, are allowed to demonstrate their economic and financial capacity through alternative documents. These documents should serve as substitutes for the financial capacity certificate.
