1. The Project Management Unit (PMU) of the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria has secured funding to finance the consolidation of the fight against malaria in Togo, and intends to use part of these funds for work materials for the benefit of 7,500 community health workers (CHWs). The supplies must be delivered within one month (1) month at the latest from receipt of the approved contract service order.
2. The Global Fund's Project Management Unit (PMU) solicits closed bids from eligible candidates who meet the required qualifications for the delivery of said supplies in a single and indivisible lot as described in section V "Cahier de clauses techniques".
3. The procurement will be conducted by international competitive bidding as defined by the PMU's administrative, financial and accounting procedures manual and open to all eligible candidates.
4. 5. The qualification requirements are:
 - the legal conditions of the company;
 - the financial conditions of the business;
 - the technical capacity of the company.

See the specific tender data for detailed information. However, the administrative documents required in clause IC 11.1 of the particular data are not eliminatory to the preliminary examination; but they are for the candidate evaluated with the lowest bid and meeting the qualification criteria in the event that he has not provided them. In this

case, the evaluation committee will make sure to ask it to provide the said documents as additional information before awarding the contract or eliminating it. On the other hand, the qualification documents required in clause IC 5.1 of the specific data are eliminatory.

NB: "Newly created companies which are unable to provide the financial statements for the last three (3) years (2018, 2019 and 2020) required are authorized to prove their economic and financial capacity by any other substitute document distinct from the 'certificate of financial capacity'

6. Interested candidates can collect the complete invitation to tender dossier free of charge on CD ROM supplied by themselves or by e-mail at the address mentioned in point 4 above.
7. Tenders must be submitted to the address mentioned in point 4 above no later than **September 7, 2021 at 10:30 a.m. UT**. The Late bids will not be accepted.
8. Bids must include a bank bid guarantee, in the amount of three *million eight hundred thousand (3,800,000) F CFA (About \$6900)*
9. Candidates will remain committed by their offer for a period of 120 days from the deadline for submitting tenders.
